Directions to Ledges Sporting Horses

Coming from the North on Hwy. 90, take the Rockton Road exit and turn left at the top of the ramp. Go to the first street, (approx. 3 blocks) which will be Love Road and turn right. The ledges Facility is located on Love Road approximately 2 miles on the right hand side.

Coming from the South on Hwy. 90, you will also take the Rockton Road exit and turn right at the top of the ramp. Love Road will be approximately 60 feet away and you will turn right and follow the same directions as above.

Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts

Per USEF Rule 301.5, effective April 1, 2005-5. (a) Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 7. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Protective Headgear

All exhibitors are required to wear properly fitting protective headgear when jumping on the show grounds. Additionally, USEF requires that all juniors riding in Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting headgear, passing or surpassing current applicable ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards with harness while riding anywhere on competition grounds. The headgear harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. Any exhibitor may were protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) in any division or class without penalty from the judge. Except as may otherwise be mandated by local law, the Federation strongly encourages all riders to wear protective headgear passing or surpassing current applicable ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards with harness while riding anywhere on competition grounds. It is the responsibility of the rider, or parent or guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriated safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition, and the Federation, Show Committee and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance.

Damage

All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.

Schooling

Schooling will be permitted in the Hunter rings up to one hour prior to start time. No lunging in show arenas or schooling arenas. Lunging is only permitted in designated lunging areas. All lunging areas will be clearly marked.

Championships

Championships and Reserves awarded in all Hunter and Jumper divisions. You must be entered in entire division to be eligible for Championship and Reserve points.

Coggins

Effective January 1, 1995 - All Illinois Equine (horses, ponies, mules, ect.) 12 months old and older participating in an advertised equine event ("Advertised equine event" means a show, rodeo, exhibition, trail ride or horse fair, excluding sales or auctions, that is posted or media promoted.) must be accompanied by a negative test for equine infectious anemia/E.I.A. (coggins/CELISA) conducted within the previous 12 months. A health certificate is required for Illinois Equine.

Prize Money

Prize money will be available by check in the Horse Show office or premiums can be subracted from your payment due. Once a reward has been made, the responibility for the horse show shall

Adds

Class adds may only be made in the Horse Show Office on the Official Form, by letter or by Facsimile and must be received prior to the start of the class. Any other method will not be considered valid

Class Adds - Class adds will be charged a \$5.00 fee per class in addition to class entry fee only if adding on the day of a class. There is no additional fee to add prior to the day of a class. Day of adds may require the exhibitor to work first in the Order of Go.

Attention all exhibitors & trainers

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ENTERED IN THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE ON THE DAY PRIOR TO SHOWING OR THERE WILL BE A \$5.00 PER CLASS ADD FEE DUE! This is going to be policy for all of the Ledges Shows throughout the year. By doing this, it will help Show Management to regulate and alter the schedule as needed depending on the number of horses. With everyone's help regarding this issue, we hope to be able to have the shows run more efficiently.

Non-Negotiable Checks

Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a penalty of \$50.00 or 10% of the face amount of the check, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment, including penalty, which must be paid in certified funds, cashiers check or money order. Over night mail service is advised to avoid notification of the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action. Exhibitors are hereby forewarned that first time returned checks will be reprocessed automatically.

Stalls

Horses and ponies must have a stall. Stabling is limited to 250 horses in 10'x10' permanent stalls with steel doors. Stalls are in permanent buildings. Stalls will be available at 7:00am on the preceding day of each horse show and fees are \$150.00 per stall. Tack stalls are \$150.00 per stall and are limited. Early stabling my be available by contacting Perfecta Farm at 630-289-8488 or Kim Gardiner 630-890-5938, and making the necessary arrangements. Additional fees may be charged for the service. After reserving your stalls, you will be changed for all of your no shows.

Jump Order

A rotating jump order will be establish for all classes over fences and such shall be posted by the in-gate. Courses will be posted at the in-gate. The management reserves the right to the use of a dotted-line in any hunter and equitation classes.

Feed and Bedding

Feed and bedding orders will be taken through the show secretary. These orders must be taken by 1:00 p.m. each day. There will not be a first bedding in the stalls. Due to the cost of manure removal, all shavings must be purchased from the Horse Show. You much phone in early with your shaving needs Remember - No outside shavings or straw!

Classics

In order to ride in the Classic, you must be entered in the entire division.

Lease Law

All dogs must be restrained at all times while on the show grounds. Unrestrained dogs create a serious safety hazard to exhibitors and their horses. Therefore, non-compliance with the leash law will not be tolerated. Loose dogs will be picked up and detained until the owner has paid a fine of \$100.00 .A second offense may cause the owner to be barred from showing and expelled from the show grounds. Refusal to pay fine will bar the owner from further participation in the horse show and the owner will not be entitled to any refund or stabling fees paid or due. Management reserves the right to call animal control to have the animal removed from the premises.

Every entry shall constitute an agreement that the person making it, owner, lessee, trainer, agent, manager, coach, rider, and the horse shall be subject to the constitution and rules and regulations The Illinois Hunter and Jumper Association, Perfecta Farm Show & Ledges Sporting Horses.
